Dear Mother, help me to know what I am to do, how I am to follow your Son, what I should do to come closer to Him. Help me to know that however much I might have gone away from this truly special love, I will not be left alone, and that you will always encourage me to start again, to just keep trying and even this could help others to find Your Son.
